June 11, 1926

1. A meeting of the Faculty was held on the call of President Clapp, who presided, at 4:10 P. M.
2. The minutes of the meeting of May 17th were approved.
3. The following members were present: Arnoldson, Atkinson, Beck, Bennett, Carey, W. P. Clarke, Corbin, Cox, Daughters, Dixon, Elrod, Freeman, Gleason, Graff, Hoffman, Howard, Jesse, Jaux, Leaphart, McKenzie, Maddock, Merrill, Mirrielees, Morris, Phillips, Polley, Rees, Rowe, Sanford, Chester Smith, DeLoss Smith, Major G. L. Smith, Speer, Stone, Suchy, Terry, Underwood, Flora Weisberg.

The following were accounted for: Bateman, Fay Clark, Colvin, Cook, Crumbaker, Finch, Keele, Kirkwood, LeClaire, Pamskill, Scheuch, Sedman, Severy, Shallenberger, Spaulding, Stimpert, Thomas, R. T. Young.

4. Mr. Carey, Chairman Faculty Affairs Committee, gave a financial report for the preceding year.

5. The following petitions were presented by the Committee on Admission and Registration, Phillips, Chairman:

*Petitions (Individual)*  
Stockton, Ella C., to graduate under the "D grade" rule, as she was in attendance three quarters prior to adoption of the grade point rule, and since the adoption of the rule has maintained an average of "C". Recommended by Committee. Petition unanimously approved by the Faculty.

Reynolds, Catherine, to graduate with 192 credits and 191 grade points (one grade point deficient). Presented without recommendation. Elrod, seconded by Rowe, moved to grant petition; Phillips, seconded by Underwood, moved to table motion, which was lost. The motion to grant the petition was then approved on a divided vote.

6. Rowe moved to approve present candidates for graduation who had the required number of credits and an equal number of grade points *"D" rule* for B. A. degree (186 credits and 186 grade points) provided they entered prior to September, 1924, and were eligible for graduation under the "D grade" rule. The motion was duly seconded, and after discussion was lost.

Phillips, seconded by Rowe, moved to add to the list of approved candidates the following, who were deficient in grade points: Leslie Hazard (165 credits, 161 grade points, 4 grade points deficient); Algeroy LeClaire (198 credits, 191½ grade points, 6½ grade points deficient); Veronica Mountain (190 credits, 186½ grade points, 3½ grade points deficient); John Alton Pearce (106 credits, 103 grade points, 3 grade points deficient). The motion was adopted by a vote of 18 to 8.


