9. The faculty then proceeded to the election of a member of the Service Committee. On motion of Lennes, seconded by Rowe, Professor Elrod was re-elected by unanimous viva voce vote.

The President announced the re-appointment of Professor Leaphart as the President's appointee.

10. The faculty then proceeded to the election of the chairman of the Budget and Policy Committee. A nominating ballot was taken and on motion of Rowe the six highest were then voted on (Elrod, Merriam, Rowe, Phillips, Maddock, Jesse). In the next ballot, the three highest were voted on (Elrod, Maddock, Merriam). In the next ballot the two highest (Elrod and Maddock) were voted upon, and Professor Elrod was declared elected.


The faculty then adjourned to their respective groups for the further election of members of the Budget and Policy Committee. The following elections were subsequently reported:
