1. A meeting of the Faculty was held on the call of the President at 4:10 P. M., with President Clapp presiding.

3. The minutes of the meeting of June 3rd were approved.

4. The following announcements were made by the President:

Final Examinations: Final examinations for the summer quarter will be given at two of the last regular class periods. In no case should they be given prior to Wednesday, August 17th. Classes will be held through Friday, August 19th.

Exemption of Seniors: The faculty has ruled that seniors completing requirements for degrees at the end of the summer session shall not be exempted from examinations held at the close of the summer session. (Minutes of March 8, 1927)

Grades: Grades will be due Wednesday, August 24th. Unless special arrangements are made with the President, instructors are required to turn in grades before leaving town.

5. The Committee on Admission and Registration, Phillips, Chairman, recommended that the faculty approve the following students as candidates for degrees and certificates at the end of the summer quarter, 1927, with the provision that they complete the requirements for their respective degrees and certificates in accordance with faculty rules.


