August 14, 1930

1. A meeting of the faculty was held at 4:10 P. M. on the call of President Clapp, who presided.

2. The following members of the faculty were present: Ames, Angus, Atkinson, Byrd, W. P. Clark, Daughters, Hoffman, Housman, Kast, Maclay, Merrill, Miller, Riedell, Scherf, Smith, Speer, Thomas, Wahlin.

The following member was accounted for: Phillips.

3. The Committee on Admission and Graduation, Phillips, Chairman, recommended that the faculty accept the following students as candidates for degrees and certificates at the end of the summer session, 1930, with the provision that they complete the requirements for their respective degrees and certificates in accordance with faculty rules: (Certified by Registrar August 21 as having completed all requirements.) The recommendation was unanimously approved by the faculty.


