47 Whereas, Many students rely on public transit, and if the Mill Levy passes, many more students
48 would be able to live without a car and/or otherwise reduce their transportation expenses;

50 Whereas, Many students work jobs that fall outside of the current service operations of Mountain
51 Line;

53 Whereas, Expanding service makes it safer for students who need to get home at night, work
54 during the weekend, and/or require paratransit;

56 Whereas, ASUM Transportation and Mountain Line have maintained a cooperative symbiotic
57 relationship in the past aiming to complement each other's services to provide the most efficient
58 transportation system for students at the University;

60 Whereas, The benefits from expanding Mountain Line's service would benefit all students and
61 the broader Missoula community;

63 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That the ASUM formally endorse the upcoming Mill Levy
64 increase as seen on the November 3rd, 2020 election day ballot;

66 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That the Mountain Line Transit System and the Friends of
67 Mountain Line Organization be allowed to add the Associated Students of the University of
68 Montana (ASUM) and the ASUM Logo to their endorsement list;

70 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That ASUM encourages students to vote in the November
71 2020 election for the Mill Levy increase;
