1. A meeting of the faculty was held at 4:00 P.M. on the call of President Clapp, who presided.

5. The President called the attention of the faculty to the fact that purchasing procedure was under the control of the State Purchasing Agent and that all matters concerning purchases should go through the business office.

6. On motion of Mr. Carey of the Faculty Affairs Committee, the faculty unanimously voted to reduce the annual assessment from \$1.00 to 50¢.
