MISSOULA -- More than 50 per cent of all Montana State University alumni remain in Montana, it has been revealed in a statistical study prepared by the MSU Alumni Association. For the rest, most former MSU students remain in the West. Aside from Montana itself, California gets most MSU alumni, getting approximately 11 per cent of the alumni, with the state of Washington not far behind.

Oregon rates next in attraction for former Grizzlies, with Idaho, Colorado, and Wyoming following in that order. In states east of the Mississippi, Illinois and New York are the leaders, rating about 1 per cent each in the former MSU student crop.
