Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) is bound by its governing documents;

Whereas, ASUM Executive pay rate and allowable hours are stipulated in the Personnel Policy;

Whereas, Each ASUM Executive makes minimum wage + \$0.50 and is restricted to a set number of hours;

Whereas, The President is allowed to claim significantly more hours compared to the Vice President and Business Manager;

Whereas, Each position usually works more hours than they are allowed to claim;

Whereas, This creates a bigger disparity for the Vice President and Business Manager since they get paid less due to less hours they can claim;

Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That section 3.0 of personnel policy be amended to read:

ASUM President	Minimum Wage + \$0.50	56.00
ASUM Vice President	Minimum Wage + \$0.50	56.00
ASUM Business Manager	Minimum Wage + \$0.50	56.00

Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That the ASUM Senate authorize a transfer of \$4,567.00 from the State Term Investment Poll (MST009) to the ASUM Administration (MST000) to account for the increase in hours;

Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That this resolution take effect for Fiscal Year 2022;
