



- (1) Deduction of annual membership fee of \$1.00 of the Teachers Retirement System is made from September payroll.
- (2) Communications from and to the Administrator for Montana of the War Savings Staff of Montana concerning purchase of War Bonds were read and the matter referred to the special faculty committee relative to the war bond purchases.
