Robert Hoyem, tenor, will present a recital in the Music School Recital Hall at Montana State University Wednesday, July 19 at 8:15 p.m. A 1954 graduate of MSU, Hoyem has been engaged to sing with the Heidelberg Opera Company in Germany during the 1961-62 season.

Hoyem earned a masters degree at the Manhattan School of Music in New York in 1958 and taught at Brooklyn the following year. He was a soloist in the Broadway musical production of "Juno" in 1959.

In 1959 he went to Germany to continue his studies under a Fulbright Scholarship. The winner of several musical awards, Hoyem has been assigned to sing several leading tenor roles with the Heidelberg Opera Company during the coming season

His recital Wednesday night will include selections from Beethoven, Wolf, Tchaikovsky, Poulenc and a group of folksongs from the British Isles. Rudolph Wendt of the MSU Music School will accompany Hoyem.
