### **INTERNATIONAL TRADE INTERNSHIP AVAILABLE THIS SPRING**

#### **MISSOULA —**

The University of Montana-Missoula invites college students interested in international trade to apply for a marketing internship for spring 2004. The internship is offered by the Montana World Trade Center and the Office of International Programs.

The intern will be based in Missoula and required to work 20 hours per week helping to coordinate the center's upcoming trade mission to Australia and New Zealand. The student will receive a monthly \$500 stipend for three months, plus air travel and accommodations for 10 days in Australia and New Zealand.

In addition, MWTC invites students who will be on exchange in New Zealand or Australia to participate in the mission. Up to 10 internships are available for Montana students who will be based in Australia or New Zealand next semester. They will help conduct market research and assist with various logistics for the mission.

MTWC is specifically seeking upper level undergraduate or graduate students who have taken extensive international business course work. To apply, submit an application, writing samples and resume by Friday, Jan. 30.
