7 Whereas, The University of Montana (“UM”) has an online map of automated external
8 defibrillators (“AEDs”) on the UM campus;

9
10 Whereas, UM does not provide information about the locations of first aid kits on the UM
11 campus;

13 Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana’s (“ASUM”) Board on Member
14 Organizations (“BOMO”) requires all Member Organizations to have access to a first aid kit;

15
16 Whereas, Member Organizations have previously struggled to adequately demonstrate their
17 access to first aid kits on required risk mitigation forms;

19 Whereas, There is no broadly displayed definition of what constitutes as a usable first aid kit on
20 the UM campus;

22 Whereas, The safety of UM students is paramount, and the knowledge of first aid kit locations on
23 campus is beneficial;

25 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That the Office of Risk Management (“ORM”) establishes an
26 official standard for what constitutes as a registered first aid kit on campus;

27
28 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That the official standard for the registration of UM first
29 aid kits complies with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (“OSHA”) number
30 1910.266 App A. standard for minimally acceptable first aid kits within the mandatory regulation
31 of first aid kits¹;

33 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That for each AED on campus, a corresponding first aid
34 kit will also be stationed;

36 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That ORM constructs an online page on UM’s website
37 detailing where each registered first aid kit is located on campus;

39 Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That this Resolution be sent to Chuck Emmett, Safety
40 Program and Emergency Manager; Gwen Coon, ASUM Office Manager; Jason Sloat, Risk and
41 Insurance Manager.
