The custom-engraved bricks are located on the UM campus Oval surrounding the landmark grizzly bear statue. Centennial Circle was created in 1993 when the University celebrated its 100th birthday. The circle is paved with red bricks that can be engraved with the names of students, alumni, family members, friends, teachers or anyone else. Or write your own personalized message of up to 42 characters.

A brick gift certificate even fits perfectly in a Christmas stocking or enclosed in a greeting card.

The bricks are a great way to give a lasting memento and a piece of UM history, as well as a gift that keeps on giving. Funds from the brick sales support special UM programs and projects.

Centennial Circle Bricks cost \$150 each and are tax-deductible. They can be engraved with up to three lines of 14 characters per line. Bricks may be ordered throughout the year, but
