### **KALISPELL-AREA STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS**

Several **Kalispell**-area students have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

Two students won Haynes Foundation scholarships. Courtney Fisher won an \$8,000 scholarship. A 2007 graduate of Flathead High School, she is a UM freshman majoring in pharmacy and the daughter of Robert and Angela Fisher of Kalispell.

Emily Joy won a \$2,000 Haynes scholarship. A 2003 graduate of Whitefish High School, she is a UM senior majoring in liberal studies and Spanish and the daughter of Tom and Darnell Joy of **Whitefish**.

Jack and Isabel Haynes, who owned and managed several Yellowstone Park photo shops, established the scholarship fund in 1960

Kadie Zimmerman received a \$6,000 Louis V. Dubay Scholarship. A 2007 graduate of Flathead High School, she is a UM freshman majoring in fine arts. Her parents are Ron and Kelley Zimmerman of Kalispell.

The A.B. and Florence Hammond Scholarship was established in 1957 by Mrs. Frank B. King in memory of her father and mother. The Hammonds were one of the founding families of Missoula, and Missoula's Hotel Florence was named after Florence Hammond.

Lucy Beard received a \$1,500 Clyde Wood Memorial Scholarship. A 2004 graduate of Flathead High School, she is a UM senior majoring in art. Her parents are Jack and Leslie Beard of Kalispell.

The Clyde Wood Memorial Scholarship was established in 1989 through numerous contributions from friends and family members.
