McHale Anderson received a \$1,500 A.B. and Florence Hammond Scholarship. He graduated from Big Sky High School this year and plans to major in business at UM. His parents are Susan and Mark Anderson of Missoula.

Owen Ross, who plans to major in music at UM, was awarded a \$1,500 A.B. and Florence Hammond Scholarship. He is the son of Laurie Franklin and Sandy Ross of Missoula.

The Hammond scholarship fund was established in 1957 by Mrs. Frank B. King in memory of her parents.

Haynes Foundation scholarships went to Kimberly Brevik, Julia Carlson and Kathren Mikelsons.

Brevik received a \$2,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship. She is a senior in French education at UM. She graduated from Hellgate High School in 2002 and is the daughter of Judy and Terry Christensen of **Plains** and Dale and Candyce Brevik of **Polson**.

A \$4,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship went to Carlson, a UM sophomore majoring

Mikelsons was awarded a \$2,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship. She is a freshman at UM and a 2006 graduate of Hellgate High School. Her parents are Martin and Vickie Mikelsons of Missoula.

Jack and Isabel Haynes, who owned and managed several Yellowstone Park photo shops, established the scholarship fund in 1960.

Holly Matz, a 2007 graduate of Valley Christian School, received a \$1,300 Alan Lee Boyer Memorial Scholarship. She is the daughter of Scott and Tracy Matz of Missoula.

The memorial scholarship was established in 1979 by Mr. and Mrs. Charles Boyer for their son, missing in action in Laos in March 1968 and listed as presumed killed in action in January 1979.

Janna Nickerson, a 2006 graduate of Hellgate High School and sophomore in anthropology at UM, received a \$6,000 Fox Foundation Scholarship. She is the daughter of Ross and Norma Nickerson of Missoula.

The Fox Foundation Scholarship was established in 1960 by the estate of Sadie Fox, who moved to Montana with her family in 1887, first to Helena and then to a ranch near Stark.

Alyssa Northrop was awarded a \$3,100 W.J. Gallagher Hobson Scholarship. She is a

UM sophomore majoring in pre-nursing. Northrop graduated from Big Sky High School in 2006. She is the daughter of Randy and Wyann Northrop of Missoula.

The scholarship was established in 1997 through the estate of Gallagher, a 1925 graduate of UM.

A \$1,500 David C. Wheeler Scholarship went to Brittany Markland, a 2007 graduate of Sentinel High School. Markland is the daughter of Ronald and Christine Markland of Missoula.

The scholarship was established by Wheeler's estate.

An \$800 Richard Paul Coombs/Alumni Association Memorial Award went to Andriana Stube, an anthropology and pre-physical therapy major at UM. Stube is a 2002 graduate of Hellgate High School and the daughter of Lori Conner and David Stube of Missoula.

The scholarship was established in 1990 by Mr. and Mrs. W.R. Coombs in memory of Richard, who was an honor student at UM at the time of his death.

Dian Gunter received a \$1,400 Donald Gute Memorial Scholarship and a \$200 Montana State Federation of Black Women's Clubs Scholarship. She is a freshman at UM majoring in social work. She graduated from Sentinel High School in 1979 and is the daughter of Bill and Shirley Gunter of Missoula.

The memorial scholarship was established in 1966 by Mr. and Mrs. J. Russell Gute in

memory of their son, who was killed in an automobile accident soon after completing his first quarter at UM in 1961.

The Montana State Federation of Black Women's Clubs Scholarship was established in 1972 by Octavia Bridgewater, who was treasurer of the organization for 22 years. The club disbanded that same year and contributed its remaining stock toward the scholarship.

Meghan Holder, a UM senior in human biological sciences, received a \$1,000 Washington Scholarship for Montanans. She is a 2003 graduate of Hellgate High School and the daughter of Ruth Anne Brown and Ron Holder of Missoula.

The scholarship fund was established in 1994 by the Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation.

A \$675 George P. and Margaret D. Sarsfield Scholarship went to Patricia O'Brien, a graduate student at UM in health promotion. O'Brien is a 1997 graduate of Sentinel High School. Her parents are Carol Hurly of Missoula and Dan O'Brien of Central Point, Ore.

The scholarship was established in 1993 through the estates of the Sarsfields, who were both graduates of UM and recipients of the University's Distinguished Alumni Award.

UM senior Sean Gibbons received a \$315 Robert M. Burgess Memorial Scholarship and a \$1,875 Elizabeth Jestrab-Chaffee Memorial Scholarship.

Gibbons majors in French, microbiology and cellular and molecular biology at UM. He

is a 2002 graduate of Sentinel High School and the son of Mark and Pam Gibbons of Missoula.

The Robert M. Burgess Memorial Scholarship was established through his will in 2001.

The Elizabeth Jestrab-Chaffee Memorial Scholarship was established in 1989 through Elizabeth's will in honor of herself and her family.

David O'Hagan, a junior in German and computer science at UM, received a \$133 Henry and Marguerite Ephron Award in Classical Languages. He is a 2005 graduate of Hellgate High School and the son of Ann and Mike O'Hagan of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

The scholarship was established in 1986 by the Ephrons, both classical languages scholars. Marguerite Ephron taught at UM from 1935 to 1975.

A \$1,000 Local Loggers Scholarship went to Lacey Hawkins, a senior at UM majoring in journalism. Hawkins is a 2003 graduate of Big Sky High School. Her parents are Thomas and LeeAnn Hawkins of Missoula.

The officers of the Local Loggers' Invitational Golf Tournament established the scholarship in 2000.
