ELTON JOHN CONCERT TICKET PROCEDURES CLARIFIED

MISSOULA—

GrizTix at The University of Montana would like to clarify the ticket-purchasing process for the Sept. 28 Elton John concert in the Adams Center.

Buyers wishing to purchase tickets in person must come to the Adams Center lobby between 3 and 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 4, to receive a numbered wristband. Ticket buyers will be able to choose from one of four purchasing locations when they pick up their wristband at the Adams Center.

The next day, Wednesday, Sept. 5, buyers will go to their chosen ticket-purchasing location: the Adams Center box office, The Source in the University Center, Southgate Mall and Worden's Market. At 9:30 a.m., randomly selected numbers will determine the line order at each location. Tickets will go on sale at 10 a.m.

Tickets are \$97 and \$67 each in price levels 1 and 2, respectively. There is a six-ticket limit per purchase. Tickets also will be sold online at <http://www.griztix.com> or by calling 888-MONTANA (666-8262) after 10 a.m. Wednesday. Buyers do not need a wristband to purchase online or by phone.
