HOLOCAUST EDUCATION WORKSHOPS OFFERED AT UM

MISSOULA –

Holocaust education workshops will be held at The University of Montana Wednesday and Thursday, Oct. 10-11, in the University Center Ballroom.

The workshops feature “Echoes and Reflections: A Multimedia Curriculum on the Holocaust.” The Wednesday workshop is geared to teachers of sixth through 12th grades. Registration begins at 3:30 p.m., with the workshop running from 4 to 7 p.m.

The Thursday workshop, co-sponsored by Region 5 Comprehensive Systems for Personnel Development, runs from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., with registration beginning at 8:30 a.m. Six hours of Office of Public Instruction renewal credit can be earned by attending this workshop. There is no registration fee for either workshop. Participants will receive a complimentary copy of the “Echoes and Reflections” curriculum. A light dinner and refreshments will be served Wednesday; attendees at the Thursday workshop will receive breakfast and lunch.
