Statement of Senator Mike Mansfield (D. Mont.)

National Translator Association

Mr. President, Montana is proud to be the home state of the President of the National Translator Association, Nat Allen of Roundup, Montana. Nat Allen has been active in the activities of this Association for many years. He recently brought to my attention the address made to the National Translator Association's Annual Banquet by Lester W. Lindow, Executive Director of the Association of Maximum Service Telecasters. This is a fine statement on the current status of translators and cable. As my colleagues here in the Senate know, there is a continuing debate between these two aspects of telecommunications and I offer this one interpretation and ask that it be printed at the conclusion of my remarks.
