#### NEW BUSINESS


Risse proposed that ASMSU hire a big name band to play at Homecoming next year. He said that the Alumni might be persuaded to help with the cost, and that the publicity would compensate for the monetary loss. He mentioned that Ralph Marteri demanded a \$2000 guarantee, with \$1000 in advance. Keefe suggested that the discussion be tabled until the next meeting, when he could have more definite information for Central Board to consider. Bradley so moved, Sankovich seconded. Passed 12-0.

Risse proposed that Central Board consider adding to our campus Blue Key, a senior men's honorary. MSU has been approached by this honorary organization as now being eligible for a chapter. As this organization's relationship with Silent Sentinel seemed vague, it was recommended that the Secretary inquire further into this movement before it is considered further.

Risse recommended that ASMSU endorse the Community Concert Program again this year. He asked that anyone interested in selling tickets contact Janet McFarland or himself.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
