Biology 595-07, Census Methods

The course will be devoted to reading the classic literature related to bird survey methods, with special focus on the development of a point-count protocol. This background will be followed by hands-on calculation of bird density using the USFS landbird monitoring database and computer programs designed to adjust point-count data, and with additional reading in the current literature about the potential biases associated with point-count methodology.
