HELENA STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA—

Eleven students from **Helena** have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

Bonhomme Scholarships went to the following students:

- Kasey Mulcahy, a UM sophomore in recreation management, received a \$1,000 scholarship. He is a 2007 graduate of Helena High School. His parents are Mac and Michelle Johnson and Mark and Debbie Mulcahy of Helena.
- Jennifer Racicot Bardsley, a UM senior in art, received a \$2,000 scholarship. She is a 1993 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Karen and Patrick Racicot of Helena.
- Anne Sherwood, a UM junior in communication studies, received a \$1,250 scholarship. She is a 2006 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Rick and JoAnne Sherwood of Helena.

The Bonhomme Scholarship Fund was established in 2001 by the estate of Peter and Elvi Bonhomme of Big Timber.

Jacie Darlington, a UM freshman and 2008 graduate of Capital High School, received a \$4,500 Louis V. Dubay Scholarship. Her parents are Kelly and Lisa Darlington of Helena.

The Louis V. Dubay Scholarship was established from the estate of Dubay, a longtime Missoula resident.

Andrew Glueckert, a 2009 graduate of Capital High School, received a \$1,500 Lulu L. Miles/Gamer Shoe Co. Memorial Scholarship. His parents are Pat and Ann Glueckert of Helena.

The Lulu L. Miles/Gamer Shoe Co. Memorial Scholarship was established in 1971 through the estate of Lulu Miles, who came to Helena as a bride in 1906, and by funds from the Fredrick Gamer family. Gamer was an early footwear merchant who established a store in Helena in 1867. A portion of the scholarship fund also came from the estate of Benjamin Tatem, an early pioneer blacksmith-miner in the Helena and Lincoln areas.

Ashley Griffith, a UM senior in dance, received a \$1,000 Bill Kliber Memorial Scholarship. She is a 2005 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Earl and Dorothy Griffith of Helena.

The Bill Kliber Memorial Scholarship was established in 2000 by the School of Fine Arts Advisory Council in memory of Kliber, an ardent supporter of the arts on campus.

Amanda Grove, a UM graduate student in physical therapy, received a \$629 James W. Wedum Memorial Scholarship and a \$1,000 Chris LePore Scholarship in Physical Therapy. Grove is a 2003 graduate of Helena High School. Her parents are Joseph and Kelle McMahon of Helena.

The James W. Wedum Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 1957 through the will of Arnold G. Wedum in memory of his father.

The Chris LePore Scholarship in Physical Therapy was established in 1995 by LePore, who received her bachelor's degree in health and physical education from UM in 1977.

Lela O'Bryant, a UM senior in drama, received a \$500 Concessions Scholarship. She is a 2005 graduate of Helena High School and the daughter of Monty O'Bryant of Helena and Cynthia O'Bryant of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

Caitlin O'Neill, a UM junior in drama, received a \$500 Concessions Scholarship. She is a 2007 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Dennis and Christine Homer of Helena.

Hannah Paton, a UM senior in drama, received a \$700 Mary Cardell Moore and Robert and Florence Cardell Memorial Scholarship in Drama. She is a 2006 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Judy and Dave Paton of Helena.

The Mary Cardell Moore and Robert and Florence Cardell Memorial Scholarship in Drama was established in 1999 by the estate of Mary Cardell Moore, a 1930 graduate of UM.

Aimee Ryan, a UM junior in political science, received a \$4,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship. She is a 2006 graduate of Capital High School and the daughter of Tom Ryan and Heidi Goldman of Helena.

Jack and Isabel Haynes, who owned and managed several Yellowstone Park photo shops, established the scholarship fund in 1960.
