Praetzel, a UM freshman in business administration, received an \$800 Joyce Lassise Merit Scholarship. He is a 2008 graduate of Flathead High School and the son of Steve and Lisa Praetzel of Lakeside.

The Joyce Lassise Merit Scholarship was established in 1990 by Dr. Mark Lassise in memory of his mother, who earned an education degree at UM.

Michelle Tanberg, a 2009 graduate of Flathead High School, received a \$1,000 Wade and Olive M. Riechel Scholarship. She plans to major in music and creative writing at UM. Her parents are Mark and Tamara Tanberg of Lakeside.
