HAMILTON STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA—

Six students from **Hamilton** have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

- Lauren Belland, a UM senior in dance, received a \$100 Montana Repertory Theatre/Rotary Club Award and a \$500 Odyssey of the Stars Scholarship. She is a 2006 graduate of Hamilton High School and the daughter of Noni Belland of **Kimberly, British Columbia**, and Robert Belland of **Memphis, Tenn.** The Odyssey of the Stars Scholarship is funded by Odyssey of the Stars, an annual event that showcases the University's alumni who have gone on to successful careers in the arts and UM College of Visual and Performing Arts students.
- Kaitlin Fowler, a 2009 graduate of Corvallis High School, received an \$8,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship. She plans to major in pre-pharmacy at UM. She is the daughter of Kathleen Fowler of Corvallis. Jack and Isabel Haynes, who owned and managed several Yellowstone Park photo shops, established the scholarship fund in 1960.
- Laura Monson, a UM junior in chemistry and computer science, received a \$1,500 Bonhomme Scholarship. Her parents are Dewey and Carol Monson of Hamilton. The Bonhomme Scholarship Fund was established in 2001 by the estate of Peter and Elvi Bonhomme of Big Timber.
- Brandon Printz, a UM junior in accounting, received a \$1,500 Bonhomme Scholarship. He is a 2004 graduate of Hamilton High School and the son of Linda Larson and Paul Printz of Hamilton.

- Caitlin Sager, a UM sophomore in Asian studies, received a \$6,000 Haynes Foundation Scholarship and a \$300 Robert M. Burgess Memorial Scholarship. She is a 2007 graduate of the North Dakota Institute of Independent Study and the daughter of Janet Burgess and Bill Sager of Hamilton. The Robert M.
