BROWNING STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA —

Six students from **Browning** have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

- Sharon Bremner, a 2009 graduate of Browning High School, received a \$2,500 Adele Cohe Laine Scholarship. She plans to major in elementary education at UM. Her parents are Robert and Kati Bremner of Browning. The scholarship was established in 1998 through the estate of Adele Cohe Laine, a 1938 graduate of UM.
- Aubry Calf Looking, a 2009 graduate of Browning High School, received a \$1,200 Browning Scholarship. She plans to major in biology at UM. Her parents are Mary Gordon and Patrick Calf Looking of **East Glacier**. The Browning Educational Endowment Fund was established in 2000 by Dean and Kristi Laughlin Drenzek, who taught school in Browning for several years.
- Randi Johnson, a 2009 graduate of Browning High School, received a \$1,000 Browning Scholarship. She will major in elementary education at UM. Her parents are Lester and Rochelle Johnson of Browning.
- Marcia St. Goddard, a UM graduate student in physical therapy, received a \$2,000 Andrew and Elizabeth Lassen Scholarship and a \$700 Community Medical Center Scholarship. She is a 2003 graduate of Browning High School and the daughter of Margie and Daryl St. Goddard of Browning. The Andrew and Elizabeth Lassen Scholarship fund was established in 1999 by anonymous donors in memory of the Lassens. The Community Medical Center Physical Therapy Scholarship was established in 1988 by Community Medical Center of Missoula.
- Cheri Valdovino-Garcia, a UM graduate student in education, received a \$700 Dr. John J. Hunt Scholarship and a \$500 Floyd and Marlys Ann Boschee Scholarship. The Dr. John J. Hunt Scholarship was established in 1991 by Floyd Boschee, a UM School of Education graduate, and other donors. Hunt came to Missoula as the first director of

Upward Bound in 1966. The Floyd and Marlys Ann Boschee Scholarship was established in 1995 by the Boschees, both graduates of UM's School of Education.

- Makenzie Wellman, a 2009 graduate of Browning High School, received a \$1,000 Browning Scholarship. Her parents are Terry Wellman and Jody Sabo of Browning.
