THOMPSON FALLS STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA—

Six students from **Thompson Falls** have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

- Stephanie Butler, a UM sophomore in elementary education, received an Alva C. Baird Scholarship and Montana State Federation of Black Women's Clubs Scholarship for a total of \$1,300. She is a 2007 graduate of Thompson Falls High School and the daughter of Bobbi and Nelson Butler of Thompson Falls. The Alva C. Baird Memorial Scholarship was established in 1975 by Judge George Boldt in memory of his brother-in-law, who received a bachelor's degree from UM in 1916 and a law degree from UM in 1920. The Montana State Federation of Black Women's Clubs Scholarship was established in 1972. The federation disbanded that year and contributed its remaining stock toward the scholarship.
- Cody Mosher, a 2009 graduate of Thompson Falls High School, received a \$1,000 Access Scholarship. He plans to major in business at UM. His parents are John and Barb Mosher of Thompson Falls. Access scholarships are funded through the Student Assistance Foundation in Helena.
- Jesse Mosher, a 2009 graduate of Thompson Falls High School, received a \$1,000 Access Scholarship. He plans to major in business at UM. His parents are John and Barb Mosher of Thompson Falls.
- Laura Rose, a UM sophomore in accounting, received a \$1,500 Bonhomme Scholarship. Her parents are Diane Delducco and Mike Buchan of Thompson Falls. The Bonhomme Scholarship Fund was established in 2001 by the estate of Peter and Elvi Bonhomme of Big Timber.

- Siena Sacchi, a UM freshman in accounting, received a \$1,000 Bonhomme Scholarship. She is a 2008 graduate of Thompson Falls High School and the daughter of Samuel and Deborah Sacchi of Thompson Falls.
- Alexander Saint, a 2009 graduate of Thompson Falls High School, received a \$1,000 Access Scholarship. His parents are Bill and Heather Saint of Thompson Falls.
