## ALBERTON STUDENTS RECEIVE UM SCHOLARSHIPS

#### MISSOULA —

Justin Shinn and Cleyone Talbot of **Alberton** have been awarded scholarships from The University of Montana.

Shinn, a UM senior in pre-medical sciences and exercise science, received a \$2,000 Fox

Foundation Scholarship. He is a 2004 graduate of Alberton High School and the son of Leslie

Ryan of Miles City.

The Fox Foundation Scholarship was established in 1960 by the estate of Sadie Fox, who moved to Montana with her family in 1887, first to Helena and then to a ranch near Stark. She married George Fox in 1905 and moved to Missoula in 1906.
