Central Board Minutes
November 19, 1955

The meeting was called to order by President Jystad.

LIQUOR CONTROL COMMITTEE

Fowler said that the proposed regulations and judicial board set-up are being mimeographed.

RELIGIOUS EMPHASIS SPEAKER

Fowler said that no religious emphasis speaker could come to the meeting on Friday, November 18.

SPOKESMAN REVIEW

Jystad read a letter from the editor of the spokesman Review in which the paper offered to include MSU in the offering of candidates for selection for featured students in their paper. Jystad explained that a committee for the selection of these students would be necessary. It was decided that this was an excellent project for the class officers to assume.

CLASS OFFICERS

The status of the class officers on central board was reviewed. Crippen moved that the class officers be made non-voting members of central board. Erickson seconded. Leuthold suggested that it might be more wise to include only the presidents of the classes in this category, stressing the importance of the position. Crippen withdrew his motion. Erickson withdrew second. Lambros pointed out that through this means, the advisability of a constitutional revision by ASMSU Planning as the increased size of central board's efficiency might be determined. Crippen moved that the class presidents be non-voting members of central board. Lambros seconded. passed 6-1. (Leuthold against).

INTEREST IN CENTRAL BOARD

Jystad recommended that organizations and clubs be encouraged to send delegations to central board meetings.

CHRISTMAS PARTY

Jystad suggested the possibility of Central Board sponsoring a party and free ticket to the basketball game on December 15, for underprivileged children in Missoula. He stressed the good publicity which this action would bring to the University. Fowler suggested that the Key Club at the high school might help in this venture. A committee to investigate the party was selected. This committee is: Crawford, Fowler, Bayley, Jystad, and Cogswell. The committee will find out the number of children which could be invited, the students who will sponsor and work on the party and other details.

FACULTY REPRESENTATIVE

Jystad said that he has a list of all the available faculty members who could be faculty delegates to central board. He explained that Dr. Fern can not serve in this capacity because of the affiliation of the school of religion with the university. A committee of the ASMSU officers and Leuthold was formed to select the faculty delegate.

TRADITIONS BOARD CHAIRMAN

In consideration of a new chairman for Traditions Board to fill the resignation of Gilluly, Lambros suggested that the selection be made from the students not now on the board. He explained that new ideas and enthusiasm would be brought in by this action. The group decided that the selection can be made at a later meeting, the time until that date being used by the members of central board for the purpose of thinking of suitable candidates for the position.

BASKETBALL TICKETS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS

Crippen raised the question for giving graduate students special rates for the basketball games. Fowler reviewed previous action by Budget and Finance committee in connection with this matter. The decision last year was to not permit the graduate students these special rates. Crocker suggested that this matter be referred to Budget and Finance committee, and their decision brought back to central board.

Jystad called the next meeting for Wednesday, November 23 at 1 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned.
