8,403 STUDENTS REPRESENT
2.1% GAIN FOR UM WINTER QUARTER

MISSOULA--

A total of 8,403 students are enrolled for winter quarter at the University of Montana, Registrar Wayne C. Woolston reported Wednesday (Jan. 12).

The gross enrollment figure of 8,403--representing a machine-tabulated count through Tuesday (Jan. 11)--is an increase of 174 students, a gain of 2.1 per cent compared with the gross enrollment of 8,229 a year ago.

Autumn quarter enrollment last fall was 8,800, a net figure which excludes the students who dropped out of school between the beginning and end of the quarter.

Registration for the 1972 winter quarter shows there are 5,550 men and 2,853 women enrolled.
