HUMANITIES LECTURER  
TO SPEAK FRIDAY AT UM

MISSOULA--

Dr. Maxine Van de Wetering, a lecturer in humanities at the University of Montana, will present the second in the botany-zoology free seminar series for winter quarter Friday (Jan. 21) at UM.

Dr. Van de Wetering will discuss "Personalized Instruction in the Humanities--Social Sciences Program" during the seminar, which will begin at 12:10 p.m. in room 307, UM Natural Science Building.

The speaker will describe how the smaller teacher-student ratio and the more intensive individualized instruction, including tutorials, have produced a more meaningful introduction of students to University education since the humanities-social sciences program was established at UM last year.

Dr. Van de Wetering has a bachelor's degree in physics from UCLA and doctorate in the history of science from the University of Washington.
