# AROTC UNIT AT UM NOTIFIED OF ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW UNITS

MISSOULA --

The Army ROTC department at the University of Montana has been notified by the Department of the Army that the applications of nine colleges and universities for the establishment of senior AROTC units have been approved.

Three units will fill vacancies createdby three schools which are terminating their ROTC programs--City College of New York, Oklahoma Military Academy and Stanford University.

The institutions selected for establishing Senior AROTC units include Bishop College, Dallas, Tex.; Carson-Newman College, Jefferson City, Tenn.; Fort Valley State College, Fort Valley, Ga.; Columbus College, Columbus, Ga.; Indiana Institute of Technology, Fort Wayne, Ind.; Northwestern State College, Alva, Okla.; Pennsylvania State University, Deleware County Campus, Media, Pa.; Saint Augustine's College, Raleigh, N.C., and Southern State College, Magnolia, Ark.
