FOUR COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES
ADDED TO EXCHANGE PROGRAM

MISSOULA--

Four public colleges and universities have been added to a student exchange program which includes the University of Montana.

Representatives of the National Student Exchange (NSE), with headquarters at Illinois State University, Bloomington-Normal, said the schools added include Ohio University, Athens; University of South Florida, Tampa; West Chester State College, West Chester, Pa.; and the University of Maine, Fort Kent.

The four-year-old program was initiated to provide opportunities for sophomores and juniors to leave their home campuses and attend one of the participating schools for a quarter, semester or full academic year.
