UM BAND CONCERT

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Concert Band will perform works ranging from "March for the Sultan Abdul Medjid" by Gioacchino Rossini through "The Solitary Dancer" by Warren Benson in a concert Sunday (April 16) at 8:15 p.m. in the University Center Ballroom.

Soloists for "Concertino for Three Brass and Band" by Floyd E. Werle are Paul Ulmer, Helena, trumpet; Hank Overturf, Missoula, euphonium, and Ed Cook, Missoula, tuba. Janet Eckberg, Havre, will be featured in a solo passage in "The Incredible Flutist" by Walter Piston.

Butler R. Eitel, director of University Bands, said the free public concert will also include "Sinfonietta Flamenca" by Carlos Surinach and "Chester" by William Schuman.

Prof. Eitel is conductor of the 56-member Concert Band. Lance R. Boyd is assistant conductor, and Randall L. Ware is assistant to the conductor.
