BILLINGS RABBI
TO LECTURE APRIL 18-19 AT UM

MISSOULA--

Dr. Samuel Horowitz of Temple Beth Aaron in Billings, representing the Jewish Chautauqua Society, will give free public lectures at the University of Montana on Tuesday and Wednesday (April 18-19).

On Tuesday at 4:10 p.m. the rabbi will lecture in the University Center, 360 A-B, on the subject "Jerusalem's Fulfillment to Three Monotheistic Religions." On Wednesday at 2:10 p.m. he will lecture in Fine Arts 302 on "The Dead Sea Scrolls, Pro and Con."

Dr. Horowitz lectures on college campuses under the auspices of the Jewish Chautauqua Society, an organization which strives to create better understanding of Jews and Judaism through education. The society is sponsored by the National Federation of Temple Brotherhoods. The rabbi's appearance in Missoula is cosponsored by the UM Department of Religious Studies.
