FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Montana State University has been awarded \$15,100 by the National Science Foundation to support a two-year study entitled "Physiology of Reproduction," Dean Robert W. Coonrod announced.

Dr. Philip L. Wright, chairman of the MSU Zoology Department, is director of the research project, which is concerned with mammalian reproductive cycles.

The NSF grant will finance graduate studies of Rodney Mead, who is working for a doctorate at MSU, Dr. Wright said. It will also pay the salary of a technician working on the project and cover the cost of purchase of specimens.
