Gov. Tim Babcock will be the Charter Day speaker at Montana State University, MSU President Robert Johns announced. The convocation marking the 71st anniversary of the signing of the University's charter is scheduled Monday at 2:30 p. m. and is open to the public.

Sen. Dave Manning, president of the Montana Senate, and Rep. Frank Hazelbaker, speaker of the house, will be seated on the stage as guests of honor, Dr. Johns said.

The Charter Day program will include a medley of songs of the West, arranged by J. George Hummel and sung by the Jubileers, under the direction of Joseph Mussulman. Laurence Perry will play the organ prelude.
