MISSOULA.....

Having lost to intrastate rival Montana State 21-3 in Missoula last Saturday, the University of Montana football team must strive to avoid a letdown in this weekend's encounter with the University of Idaho Vandals in Moscow.

Saturday the Grizzlies succumbed to a swarming Bobcat defense and two lightening quick touchdown passes in the 72nd meeting of Montana's two largest institutions of higher education.

The Montana State defense held the Grizzly triple option attack to 75 net rushing yards and Bobcat split end Sam McCullum grabbed 50 and 47 yard scoring passes as the Cats broke a three game UM winning streak in the series.

The Montana coaching staff had special praise for the performance of sophomore middle linebacker Ron Rosenberg against Montana State. "Rosie played his best game of the year. He played as well as you can play on defense," UM assistant coach Charley Arney said.

The Vandals have been taking their lumps this season, they have a 2-6 season record and a 0-3 conference mark, but have a talented team that has been beset by a rash of injuries to key individuals.

They have played well at home in their new stadium, which seats 18,000 and has a Tartan playing surface, with both of their wins coming in Moscow.

Last weekend Idaho was whipped by Utah State's passing attack to a tune of 51-7. The Aggies rolled up 416 passing yards on 33 completed passes in 51 attempts.

Montana concludes its season Nov. 18, in Tulsa, Ok., against the University of Tulsa.
