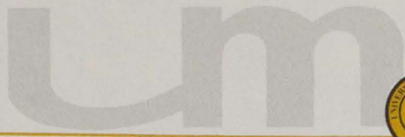

University of Montana students interested in studying abroad are invited to attend a special meeting Friday (Nov. 17) at UM for an explanation of the overseas study program.

The meeting will be a 3 p.m. in room 205 of the UM Liberal Arts Building.

Dr. John E. Van de Wetering, chairman of the UM Department of History, who is in charge of the overseas study program at UM, said students can study in Avignon, France, and London, England, under the program.
