The University of Montana women's volleyball team swept matches from Eastern Washington State College, Whitworth College and the Montana Volleyball Club of Missoula Saturday in Cheney, Washington. Scores of the three games against EWSC were 13-15, 15-4, and 15-8. Montana bested Whitworth College 15-13 and 15-11. Against the Montana Volleyball Club of Missoula, UM won handily, 15-6 and 15-8.

This week the UM team is preparing for the Northwest Tournament December 1-2 in Pullman, Washington. Teams in the tournament will be bracketed in accordance to their season record.

Montana boasts a 23-7-4 match record.
