JOHN SEBASTIAN CONCERT
JAN. 6 CANCELLED

MISSOULA--

A three-group concert sponsored by the Associated Students at the University of Montana and scheduled for Jan. 6 has been cancelled, according to Gary Bogue, ASUM Program Council Coordinator.

The concert featuring John Sebastian, Tower of ^{Power} / and Ballin'jack, was cancelled when Tower of Power withdrew from the contract.

"Their agency, American Talent International, was not able to secure en route appearance dates for the group and Tower of Power's management felt that a single date in Northwestern Montana was too isolated," Bogue said.

"Because of the lateness of the cancellation, Program Council was unable to line up another well-known group and it was decided that Sebastian headlining alone would not draw a large enough crowd," the Council coordinator explained.
