K. ROSS TOOLE TO DISCUSS
WAR BETWEEN GOVERNMENT,
AIR POLLUTION THURSDAY

MISSOULA--

Dr. K. Ross Toole, a University of Montana history professor, will discuss an early phase of the federal government's war against air pollution during a free public lecture at 7 p.m. Thursday (Feb. 7) in the University Center Lounge.

The lecture, entitled "The War Between the Government and the Smelters of the West and Air Pollution: An Historic Example of How to Lose An Environmental Battle," is sponsored by the University Center as one in a continuing series of free public programs.

Toole said Thursday's discussion will involve the smelter emission battle waged by President Theodore Roosevelt and carried on by President William H. Taft against the Anaconda Company.

Gary Bogue, director of programs for the UC, is coordinator of Thursday's program.
