DR. ROGER W. CLAPP
DIES IN WASHINGTON AREA

MISSOULA--

Dr. Roger W. Clapp, 60, who received a Distinguished Service Award from the University of Montana Alumni Association in the fall of 1972, died in the Washington, D.C., area Monday night (Feb. 18).

At the time of his death, Dr. Clapp, who was former director of medicine for the Peace Corps in Washington, D.C., was serving with a consortium of doctors on hospital emergency cases.

Dr. Clapp was graduated from Butte Public High School in 1932 and he went on to earn a bachelor's degree in zoology from UM in 1937. He was graduated from the St. Louis University Medical School in 1942.

He was appointed director of medicine for the Peace Corps on July 1, 1970.
