The University of Montana's 1973-74 basketball awards will be presented at Wednesday's meeting of the Grizzly Den in the Edgewater Restaurant.

The entire Grizzly team will be on hand for the luncheon and coach Jud Heathcote will present the C. R. Dragstedt Most Valuable Player, the John Eaheart Outstanding Defensive Player and the Naseby Rhinehart Most Inspirational Player awards.

Montana completed its finest season in 24 years last Tuesday with a 19-8 overall record. The .704 winning percentage has been bettered by only one team in the school's history. The 1949-50 Grizzlies were 27-4.

In addition to the award presentations, Heathcote will recap the season and comment on the outlook for next season.
