IS TUESDAY AT UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

Linda Fellows, who is studying for her master's degree in applied music at the University of Montana in Missoula, will present her graduate piano recital at 8 p.m. Tuesday (April 30) in the UM Music Recital Hall.

Fellows, a 1967 graduate of Sweet Grass County High School, Big Timber, received her bachelor of music degree at Concordia College, Moorhead, Minn., in 1971. She taught two years at Paris-Gibson Junior High School, Great Falls, and is now a graduate assistant in piano at UM. Fellows, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. James H. Fellows, Glasston Route, Big Timber, is organist for the Missoula Atonement Lutheran Church.

Works on Tuesday's program will include "Toccatina No. 6 in G Major" by Bach; "Sonata in C Major Opus 2 No. 3" by Beethoven; "Intermezzo in A Major Opus 118 No.2" and "Rhapsody in B minor Opus 79 No. 1" by Brahms, and "Suite Opus 14" and "Allegro Barbaro" by Bartok.

The recital is open to the public without charge under the sponsorship of the UM School of Fine Arts and Department of Music.
