Montana was blanked in singles and doubles competition by Oregon Saturday morning in Eugene. Saturday afternoon in Corvallis, UM lost 6-3 to Oregon State.

Sue Robinson and Linda Turman won their singles matches against Oregon State. The doubles pair of Turman-Gigi Meinhardt overcame its counterpart 7-6, 3-6, 6-1 to record UM's other victory.

Montana's match record stands at 5-4 for the season.
