Central Board Minutes  
Tuesday, Sept. 25, 1951

The meeting was called to order by Bill Reynolds. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Don Lucas suggested Bear Paw tapping be held on October 11. Discussion followed concerning possible dates for organization of plans and first SOS.

Mr. Badgley introduced discussion of activity ticket cost for students' wives for the coming year. Approximately sixty of these tickets have been sold in previous years, at the cost of \$5.00 per ticket. With the new activity fee raise, the cost of these tickets would be \$6.67, to be in proportion. McMasters moved that the cost of students' wives activity tickets be raised to \$6.50. The motion was carried.

Reynolds introduced discussion concerning price of community concert tickets for the coming year. Jones moved that ticket price be raised from \$2.00 to \$2.50 for the year ('51-'52). It is the plan that sales be made during registration. Miss Van Duser suggested possible publicity plans.

Temporary elections in the Freshmen class will be held Wednesday, Sept. 26, at the ASMSU convocation. As per minutes of May 31, a temporary class president will be elected. Reynolds suggested that we hold elections for Secretary of ASMSU concurrently with the final election for Freshman president.

Jones moved we accept the recommendation that Boyton Page and Clarence Coyle be alumni representatives to Athletic Board and Harold Hanson be alumni representative to Central Board. Lucas seconded. Motion carried.

Reynolds announced that four people have been hired at sixty cents per hour to sell activity tickets. Because of our membership in the new athletic conference, separate football tickets will be sold.

Reynolds said that we have a bear on hand, and could be disposed of by the Bear Paws. McMasters accepted full responsibility of the mascot.

Reynolds announced that a contract has been drawn up to provide use of University songs for publicity purposes. Wohlgenant suggested further investigation of the matter to precede Central Board approval. Final discussion and approval of the matter will be made at our next meeting.

Reynolds announced ASMSU convocation tomorrow, Sept. 26. Officers committee heads and members of Central Board will be introduced.

Reynolds presented plans for a possible card show in order to increase student attendance at University games. Lucas is to look into cost of such a plan. Dean Wunderlich suggested Freshmen rally in order to review songs, yells, and other pep activities. Mr. Badgley suggested our obtaining materials and instructions for the plan from W.S.C. Yell kings will be chosen by traditions board.

Miss Van Duser recommended that publications board make a thorough review of the Sentinel and submit criticisms and recommendations to Central Board.

A tentative meeting date was set for Tuesday, at 3:00.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
