FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

A 1964 Arlee High School graduate, Michele Wolf, has been awarded the first scholarship offered by the Montana Association of Journalism Directors.

Miss Wolf, editor of the Arlee High newspaper in 1963-1964, will receive a \$150 grant to study at the Montana State University School of Journalism. She will enter MSU as a freshman in the fall.

The award was announced by Mrs. Lois Elda Larson, president of the association and publications adviser at Laurel High School, and Warren Smith, secretary-treasurer of the directors' group and publications adviser at Joliet High School.

Funds for the scholarship were donated by 45 high schools, whose journalism students sponsored extra-curricular activities to raise money.

Miss Wolf worked on the school newspaper for two years and was copy editor of the school yearbook. Both publications received All-State ratings from the School of Journalism in their most recent evaluations.

Miss Wolf was on the honor roll at Arlee High for four years.

The Montana Association of Journalism Directors, organized in 1962, comprises journalism instructors and publications advisers in the state's high schools.
