FUND-RAISING PROJECT FOR EPILEPSY GROUP
CONTINUES IN MISSOULA

MISSOULA--

Michael M. McCarthy, a University of Montana student who is president of the Western Montana Epilepsy Association, said the WMEA still is collecting recyclable aluminum beer and pop cans and TV dinner plates and pie plates as a fund-raising project to support the nonprofit organization.

To date, about 3,000 cans have been donated toward the fund-raising effort, McCarthy said. About 240,000 cans are being sought for the WMEA.

McCarthy said that collecting the recyclable materials "probably will be a year-long project" because each recyclable can is valued at only a half-cent. Cans and other items for the WMEA may be brought to 651 S. 5th St. E.
