13 UM STUDENTS SELECTED
AS DORMITORY HEAD RESIDENTS,
ASSISTANT HR'S FOR 1974-75

MISSOULA--

Thirteen University of Montana students have been selected by the UM Residence Halls Office to work as head residents or assistant head residents in University dormitories during the 1974-75 academic year, Thomas H. Hayes, director of UM Residence Halls, has announced.

Each student chosen as a head resident or assistant head resident will live in one of the seven dormitories on the UM campus and will be responsible for the general well-being of the dormitory and the students living there. They also serve as mediators between the University administration and the students living on-campus.

Hayes said a special training program for head residents, assistant head residents and resident assistants will be held Sept. 14-21 at Camp Paxson, Seeley Lake. The "Residence Halls Staff Orientation" program will train the students in developing leadership effectiveness, communication skills, conducting counseling sessions, crisis intervention, first-aid training, residence halls policies and attitudes and food service operation.

Hayes will participate in the program as an instructor along with staff members Ron Brunell, assistant director of residence halls; Dr. Fred Weldon, director of the UM Center for Student Development (CSD); Dr. Don Hjelmseth, assistant director of the CSD; Carson Vehrs, director of UM Food Services, and members of the UM Health Service staff.
