An exhibit and sale of approximately 1,000 original prints from the Ferdinand Roten Galleries collection of Baltimore, Md., will be presented in the University Center mall at the University of Montana from 11 a.m. - 5 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 8.

Prices range from \$10 to the thousands, but most prints are under \$100.
