University of Montana students may sign up through Friday to participate in the Big Paul Bunyan and Little Paul Bunyan beard and moustache contests held in conjunction with the 58th Annual Foresters Ball, which will be Dec. 6-7 in the UM Men's Gym. Registration for the contests is in the first-floor lobby of the UM Forestry Building.

Edwin M. "Tim" Beebe, <u>Hampton</u>, <u>lowa</u>, a UM forestry student who is publicity chairman for the ball and related events which will take place during Foresters Week in December, said the Little Paul Bunyan competition will be for men who begin growing beards and moustaches after Friday. The Big Paul Bunyan competition is for UM students who already have beards and moustaches.

Beebe said beard and moustache judging will be Dec. 2 and prizes will be awarded that night at the annual Foresters Convocation.

Paul Bunyan is the legendary giant lumberjack associated with Canada and the northern and northwestern U.S.
